This step includes the required background screen and provides general liability and sports accident insurance while working licensed AAU volleyball events.

2) Complete required
officiating training
modules and pass
online exam

[AAU Volleyball Officials Online Training](#)
NOTE: Current AAU Membership AND paid
subscription to the online training site
are required to complete this step.
Both items need to be renewed annually.

Online training site has multiple training modules and the rules test. Subscriptions run concurrent with AAU membership and are on an annual basis.

3) Attend and pass a
rating event approved
by AAU National

Sites may include events such as:
AAU National Championships
Grand Prix/Super Regionals
Local AAU Events

AAU National Championships —Training team will observe selected officials during event.

Local AAU Events—Training team works with area local event hosts/assignors to offer observations opportunities for officials within their geographic area.

** NOTE: On-court evaluations must be conducted at an AAU approved training event by members of the AAU training team*

NOTE: Number of officials observed may be limited by event size and training team member availability.
