EXPECTED STANDARDS

- See QUALIFIED expectations
- Appropriate uniform white, blue or gray polo
- Whistle, lanyard, coin, red/yellow cards
- Stop/wrist watch (no cell phone for timing)

- Line Judge flags and net height chain
