Qualified	Current AAU member + completion of required on-line training modules and exam	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Appropriate uniform white, blue or gray polo</li><li>• Whistle, lanyard, coin, red/yellow cards</li><li>• Stop/wrist watch (no cell phone for timing)</li><li>• Rule book—either electronic or hard copy.</li><li>• Line Judge flags and net height chain</li></ul>
District	Meets QUALIFIED requirements + on-court evaluations* completed showing <i>competency</i> in both positions (at least 1 @ R1, 1 @ R2 , 1 match scorer)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>All QUALIFIED expectations, plus</b></li><li>• Proper uniform of navy slacks and white shoes. Ball pump and pressure gauge.</li></ul>
Regional	Meets DISTRICT requirements + on-court re-evaluations* at both R1 and R2 position, showing <i>proficiency</i> in both positions (at least 1 @ R1, 1@ R2, 1 SK)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>All DISTRICT expectations,</b></li></ul>
National	Reciprocity given to USAV JR National and National Officials and PAVO National Level Officials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>In development for future years</b></li></ul>
